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Staff Development Training, Workshops, and Seminars

The Alliance for Education and Community Development, Inc. (AECD) provides special training for those who work with American Indian and Alaska Native as well as other Diverse student populations. The workshops are specifically designed for those who work with low performing K-12 students who are in need of special assistance, particularly in the development of literacy skills in Reading and Writing, Reading Activities That Work, , Basic Math/Pre-algebra skills, and Algebra Readiness as well as Staff Development Training Sessions.

TWO DAY WORKSHOP SEMINAR SERIES

In AECD's two day workshop series, participants will discover resources which can help assess the gaps in student understanding and then provide students with powerful activities and effective instructional practice materials that will overcome many educational barriers. Participants will learn various techniques to effectively build understanding and comprehension for the students, and will take many of the resources at the end of the workshop. Participants will receive information on some of the best practices in teaching, in math and algebra, and in reading, and writing education. The Strategies are research-based and highly effective among low achieving students.

PARTICIPANTS WILL LEARN:

- How to help students perform at higher achievement levels

BUILDING MATHEMATICAL FOUNDATIONS

We will explore the fractions and decimals., and explore more instructional strategies for building understanding of equations integers. We will also review strategies to build success with word problems.

ALGEBRA READINESS (TWO DAY SEMINAR)

We will look at common misconceptions with order of operations and exponents, as well as activities that will build their mathematical foundations. We will explore Geometry as it relates to Algebra, and explore more instructional strategies instruction for building understanding of equations integers. We will also review strategies to build success with algebraic word problems.



LITERACY COUNTS

READ TO LEARN / WRITE TO LEARN I (TWO DAY SEMINAR)
Participants will learn various techniques and practices in the area of Phonemic Awareness, Phonics, Fluency, Vocabulary, and Text Comprehension. We will introduce participants to build writing abilities with tutees, the stages of writing development, the writing process, analyzing student writing problems, and practice writing techniques.

READ TO LEARN / WRITE TO LEARN II (TWO DAY SEMINAR)

We will augment what was presented in the Beginning class, and in this Reading Strategies Training Session and Writing Strategies Training Session, we will introduce participants to the latest in the highest quality, effective practices that will augment what they learned in Part One.

SPECIAL ONE DAY SEMINARS SERIES

Basic Math/Pre-Algebra That Works: Participants will learn how to increase math comprehension, provide strategies to fill in the gap of prior learning, address misconceptions with fractions and decimals, and explore the fraction-decimal relationship in preparation for Algebra.

Algebra Readiness That Works: Participants will learn Learn common misconceptions with the order of operations and exponents, and to build understanding of equations and integers. We will also review strategies to build success with word problems. Participants will take many of the resources at the end of the workshop.

Reading Strategies & Activities That Work: This one-day workshop is designed to engage Student's interest and build a longer attention span for low achieving student in grades 3-8 by utilizing ten (10) specially designed Reading and Writing Activities and the latest Strategies and Research for struggling readers. The training is geared for persons helping students who are at high risk in all academic areas because of literacy deficiencies.
